Qualifications Required

1. A Degree with specialization in a relevant subject with First Class or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours.

OR

2. A degree with specialization in a relevant subject with Second Class (Lower Division) Honours and at least 01 year of experience in teaching /research/professional work in recognized mercantile establishment /postgraduate studies in a recognized University or Higher Education Institution;

OR

3. (a) A degree with specialization in the relevant subject without Honours or any other general degree with at least Second Class Honours,
AND

- (b) A Postgraduate Degree with duration of at least 02 academic years in the relevant subject with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation;

OR

4. (a) A Degree or equivalent professional qualification offered or recognized by a professional institution established by an Act of Parliament of Sri Lanka in the relevant subject

AND

- (b) One year Masters Degree in the relevant subject or equivalent further professional qualification offered or recognized by a professional institution established by an Act of Parliament of Sri Lanka

AND

- (c) (i) Five (5) years of professional experience after graduation or after securing professional qualification given in 4 (a)

Note

1. "Degree," "Master Degree," or "Doctoral Degree" means Degree/ Master Degree/ Doctoral Degree offered by a University or a Higher Educational Institution established by an Act of Parliament of Sri Lanka or Recognized by the University Grants Commission of Sri Lanka.
2. "Degree in relevant field" means a degree relevant to the programs conducted by the University College or University of Vocational Technology.
